Capitol City Footprinter Chapter #44 was chartered June 01, 1968. Since the chapter was chartered, we have had five International Footprint Association Grand Presidents, Lou Greiner, Bill Greiner, Gene Giles, Dave Goehring and Karen Winney. We have the honor of being the first and only chapter to have had a woman, Karen Winney, nominated for, elected to and serve on the grand board as Grand President for the fiscal year 2014/2015.

During the years we have conducted 46 annual Law Enforcement Awards dinners honoring the officer of the year from Lincoln Police Department, Lincoln Fire & Rescue, Lancaster County Sheriff's Department, Lancaster County Corrections, Nebraska State Patrol, Nebraska Department of Correctional Services, Nebraska Games and Parks Commission, Nebraska Fire Marshal and the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Police Department. We have also honored the dispatchers for Nebraska State Patrol, the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Police Department, and the Lincoln Lancaster County Communication Center for the last seventeen years.

We, like other civic organization, have been having problems recruiting members and then getting them to get involved. We have been operating with a membership of less than 20 for the last several years but have only had six or seven that are active. During the Board of Directors meeting on December 18, 2021, we had a serious and lengthy discussion regarding this matter and at the Grand Convention held in Denver, CO. the week of June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022, we presented the Grand Board a written request that effective June 30, 2022 they dissolve Capitol City Footprints Chapter #44.

The above, is something that we sadly regret, but we felt we had to do.

I have been with Chapter #44 since 1984 and over the years I have been secretary for several years and Chapter President several times. I would like to "Thank" all the member present and past that have been a part of the operation of what I consider a **Greatest** origination around. I hate to see it go.
